### **Maintenance of Skatepark at Donkey Common**

Cambridge City Council hereby take full responsibility for future maintenance of the Donkey Common Skatepark for at least 10 years and beyond. The Skatepark is on Cambridge City Council's land and therefore our responsibility to ensure the area is safe, clean and operational to all that use it for time the skatepark is open to the public. All we ask in return is for Cam Skate and it's members to report any issues with the Skatepark so we can address them as early as possible to avoid the area being deemed unsafe or even closed.

We understand that any funding through Thalia will be held by you at Cam Skate for the potential Skatepark project on the Donkey Common site which we will invest a further £25,000 with some ringfenced funds to create a new skating area. We will work with you to ensure we create something that is meaningful to the skateboarding community.
